The Table of Fees is published on the LSE website (ahead of the next Admissions cycle).

Council considers, approves and signs off fee levels (June) around 15 months in advance of the academic year that the fee levels relate to. Student Numbers and Fees (SNAF) Group meets three times a year to consider fee levels and make recommendations to the Academic Planning and Resources Committee (APRC).

LSE fee level approval cycle

Finance Committee endorses fees in relation to the overall financial position of the School Annual Monitoring (AM) of Departments and Institutes takes place. New programmes including fee levels are put forward to the Pro-Vice Chancellors. (Autumn Term each year)

APRC considers the fee level recommendations from SNAF, EESC, and AM. Fee levels are endorsed (May/June) and recommended to Finance Committee and Council for approval.

The EMB meets (Dec/Jan) to discuss fee levels for executive programmes. Recommendations are put forward to EESC for endorsement. EESC then recommends the fees to APRC.
