



Type Categories

Serif

Have small extensions known an serifs at the end of some of their strokes

Sans Serif

Letterforms are deliberately plain with no flourishes or decoration

Script

Typefaces modelled on hand formed letters

Slab Serif

Serifs are large and heavy, often the same weight as the strokes

DISPLAY

Designed for large headings or short slogans, tend to have highly stylised letterforms

Combining Typefaces

- Opposites work well together try combining a serif with a sans-serif font
- Don't use similar fonts
- Keep it simple don't use more than two fonts
